Thank you in advance for your radical generosity—for stepping out in faith to make an eternal Kingdom impact in the hard places throughout *all the world*—**now.**



Last year, you launched a team of Alliance international workers into one of this country's largest cities, home to some of the region's least-reached peoples. This year, will you provide a community center for these workers to host English classes, conversational English practice sessions ("coffee nights"), and other gospel-advancing outreach events among their new neighbors?

The team's goal is to establish locally led churches so people no longer need to practice their faith in isolation. By giving to this project now, you will not only build a community center—you will also open a new door for Alliance Missions advance.



Revitalize a Community in Turmoil

Occultic influences, constant threats of violence, and widespread poverty are just a few of the obstacles to church stability and growth in Burkina Faso. Christianity has deep roots in this hard place, but for decades leaders at the Burkina Alliance National Office have worked in outdated facilities with crumbling walkways, peeling paint, and cramped rooms.

You are needed now to revitalize a community in turmoil by equipping national church leaders with upgraded facilities to host conferences, accommodate visitors, and oversee vital ministries in places like schools, radio stations, and more than 1,000 Alliance churches throughout the country.

Through your gifts to this project, you will propel the construction of a new National Office complex in Burkina Faso that will include a 200-seat conference room, offices, guest rooms, commercial spaces, and a restaurant. The income generated through the new facility will fund gospel-advancing work among under-resourced, hurting, and displaced people.

Equip a compassionate and innovative national church to maximize its gospel impact.

Accelerate Church Planting Among the Unreached

Sumatra is one of the most unreached islands on earth. Over 50 million people make up the 23 least-reached people groups.

By giving to this project, you will fuel a church-planting movement that meets culturally relevant needs through outreach initiatives involving beekeeping, brickmaking, gardening, and even the sale of office supplies.

Before this project was launched seven years ago, the Indonesian Alliance's presence in Sumatra was limited to 16 small churches. Since then, donors like you have laid the foundation for new church plants in communities long resistant—and even hostile—toward Christianity. The work is far from finished.

The purpose of this project is twofold: (1) plant 16 reproducing churches and five disciplemaking movements in this hard place; and (2) place Alliance workers among the majority religion's unreached people groups. You will supply local church planters with living space, vehicles, and other resources to carry out their vital work among overlooked and underserved Sumatrans.

Establish a Permanent House of Worship

Resistance to church planting is fierce in the Circle of Silence—a region of Mexico where only 2 percent of people identify as evangelical. Drug cartels, hostile indigenous populations, and government restrictions threaten to slow the momentum of Project South Pointe, an Alliance initiative launched in 2015 with the goal of planting 10 new churches in the Circle of Silence by the year 2025.

You are needed to furnish one congregation in this hard place with steel, cement, and other supplies to build a two-story church that will include classrooms, offices, and a sanctuary for 500 congregants. It will also serve as the operational base for future church-planting efforts in this region of 26 million people.

Each Sunday, the congregation gathers in a large tent beside the construction site, eagerly awaiting a permanent home to worship, pray, and study God's Word. Will you provide a door, a window, or even an entire wall of this new church?

Transform the Circle of Silence with the love and grace of Jesus.

Train Refugees as Church Planters

For members of this refugee community in North Africa, becoming a Christian carries great risk of being disowned by family or refused an inheritance. New believers meet secretly to worship and study the Bible. Attending seminary is so risky that most students enroll under assumed identities.

Through your gift to this project, you pave the road for church planting among displaced, isolated, and vulnerable believers who have fled genocide in their home country. Over the last five years, Christ followers from this community have been growing in their faith through discipleship and underground worship sessions. They are also learning to read the Bible in their native language, which, until recently, was unwritten.

The next phase of this work provides access to seminary classes, adult education programs, and hands-on training in starting new churches, media outreach, and children's and music ministry.

Prepare members of this refugee community now to lead vital ministries and spearhead the formation of a national church network in this hard place.



Launch Emerging Leaders in Hard Places

Because of geographical, linguistic, and religious barriers, many Indonesians are deeply divided from their countrymen. These divisions manifest themselves in many ways: land disputes, workplace discrimination, and sometimes violence.

In a divided country with over 200 unreached people groups, The Alliance's work to advance the gospel is fueled by donors who provide emerging church leaders with books, facilities, and other training resources at 12 small theological schools. One of these institutions—Simpson Bible School—is introducing an academic program to launch cross-cultural ministry among Indonesians struggling for hope, purpose, and inner peace they can never find outside God's Word. However, this pioneering work is not possible without upgraded teaching materials, facilities, and learning experiences.

Imagine how encouraged you will feel knowing that because you placed a textbook in his hands, a seminary student is studying to steer an unreached village toward Jesus. Give to this project to launch emerging leaders into the hard places within their homeland.

Rebuild Shattered Lives

More than a year since Ukraine was invaded by Russia, the country remains a hard place. Cities, towns, and villages lie in ruins. Roads and fields are littered with live mines. Millions are still displaced. Nearly everyone is scarred by the horrors and tragedies they have endured.

Your gift to this urgent project will meet the holistic needs of Ukrainians still displaced and devastated by war. These initiatives include rebuilding homes and churches, training new pastors, hosting children's camps, and investing in local businesses.

Since the invasion of Ukraine, an outpouring of generosity from people like you has fueled relief work and allowed five new Alliance-affiliated churches to spring up amid the rubble and tumult in Ukraine. The work isn't over. Nearly half of Ukrainian Alliance pastors live and minister within 20 miles of the front lines. These and other local leaders must be better trained and equipped to care for their neighbors and rebuild their communities.

Open Gospel Access to a Nomadic Population

While Christians are tolerated in this remote area of West Africa, they are vastly outnumbered and often received with suspicion, indifference, or hostility. For this reason, many believers keep a low profile, holding worship gatherings in crowded rooms with unadorned walls and hard floors padded with hand-woven mats.

You have an opportunity to establish a ministry center among rural Senegalese families—many of them nomadic cattle herders with little or no gospel access. At the ministry center, local believers and other emerging church leaders will lead training events, gather for prayer and worship, and offer refuge to believers fleeing persecution.

For over 15 years, generous Alliance donors have provided these nomadic families with access to exceptional medical care. This vital work—started by a local believer—is the only gospel lifeline for some of the least-reached peoples in this dry savanna.

Alliance workers estimate that through the ministry center you will allow 100 people each year to study God's Word and experience His love—some for the very first time.

Renovate a Community with Gospel Presence

With one of the world's highest unemployment rates, this Balkan country is a hard place for most young people to build a career. Yet, their opportunities to meet someone who follows Jesus are even more limited than their job prospects. Evangelicals make up less than 1 percent of the population, and members of the majority religion are often wary of entering a church or participating in church-sponsored activities.

By renovating a new community center in the capital of this Balkan country, you will establish a welcoming place for people of all ages and backgrounds to learn job skills, gather with friends over coffee, and experience God's generosity, compassion, and hospitality.

This project builds on work at an older community center in the same city. The popularity of their programs and outreach events at this facility have compelled Alliance international workers to acquire a larger building to broaden the gospel impact of their work.



Create Apprenticeships for the Deaf

Deaf people in this central Asian country often find themselves on the margins of society. With limited opportunities to pursue education and job training, many struggle to find stable employment. Prevailing misconceptions about deafness even lead some to believe they are cursed or unloved by God.

By giving to this project, you will enable Deaf students to enroll in apprenticeships led by master craftsmen from their communities. Through these apprenticeships, the students develop skills to pursue jobs in fields like carpentry, auto mechanics, plumbing, and cosmetology.

Some students you assist are graduates of a sign language program led by Alliance workers who have been building connections with local families for years—all for the purpose of demonstrating God's love and teaching unreached peoples about His Word. The apprenticeships are a practical way to show these and other sign language students and their families that God cares for them and provides for their every need.

Protect Isolated Farmers' Livelihoods

In this hard place, the loss of a dairy cow can be devastating for the family that depends on its milk for their livelihood. Because many farmers lack access to veterinary care, livestock commonly become ill or die of preventable causes, resulting in estimated losses of \$30 billion per year and lost food supplies for isolated communities.

Your donation to this vital project will provide livelihood sustainability to farmers through professional, affordable, and accessible veterinary services available at animal health centers and through app-based technology. Some life-sustaining services are even provided at the farmer's doorstep so families in rural areas do not have to travel long distances to treat the animals they depend on.

Most importantly, you can create opportunities for gospel impact. Because of your giving, animal care providers serve as the hands and feet of Jesus, gaining rare access into unreached villages where they may otherwise be unable to establish a meaningful, impactful presence.

Build Hope for the Urban Poor

Badshaguna—a developing community in Bangladesh—bustles with tourists, street vendors, and bicycle rickshaw drivers. Poverty and limited educational opportunities drive many women into prostitution. Few of Bangladesh's urban poor have heard the gospel or encountered the presence of Jesus.

By building a five-story community center in Badshaguna, you will pave the way for exploited and marginalized women—many of them former prostitutes and refugees—to pursue work as clothing producers and find a sense of belonging among people who share the hope for a newfound identity in Jesus. The community center will also house an educational boarding program for youth from remote hill tribes.

Your gift will expand on a vocational training program that provides up to 120 women per year with a path out of poverty and human trafficking. The foundation of the new community center has already been laid. Will you drive this project into the next phase of construction by giving cement, bricks, steel, and other vital supplies?

Train and Equip Under-Resourced Farmers

Many Senegalese farmers rely on donkey-pulled carts and hand tools to plant, tend, and harvest their crops. Their land is overworked, depleted of nutrients, and barely produces enough food for these farmers to feed their families. Worst of all, though, most of them do not know they can turn to Jesus for guidance, compassion, and provision.

Your gift to this project will train and equip families to adopt farming techniques that make their exhausting labor more fruitful. A practical way of demonstrating God's generosity and selfless love, agricultural training becomes an access point for gospel-centered conversations and discipleship in one of the world's remaining hard places.

Unlike simply providing seeds or increasing field surface area, this project teaches struggling and under-resourced farmers how to improve the quality and productivity of their soil. In this way, they become better stewards of God's creation.

Many families in this West African country toil throughout the growing season with simple farming tools in searing heat and suffocating humidity. Their grueling work brings them barely enough rice, corn, and sweet potatoes to silence their groaning stomachs. Because most lack gospel access, they also hunger daily for the spiritual nourishment only Jesus can provide.

You can demonstrate God's wisdom and redeeming love to families in this West African country by introducing them to farming practices and technologies that restore nutrients to the soil and improve crop yields.

This project began in 2015 as relief work to communities afflicted by the Ebola outbreak and has blossomed into much more. Through your gift toward agriculture training and consultation, you will equip West African farmers to overcome food insecurity without government assistance. You will also create opportunities for Alliance international workers to proclaim and demonstrate God's love among people long denied gospel access.

Provide Care and Opportunities for Immigrant Women

A mother who immigrates to New York from West Africa faces an uphill battle. She has gone from one hard place to another. To find work, communicate with her children's teachers, and pass citizenship tests, she must first learn English. Without language training, she may remain isolated, wrestling with heavy financial burdens, confusion, and trauma.

You have an opportunity now to provide ESL classes, citizenship test prep services, job training, and emotional care for West African women in New York—most of whom have recently arrived in the United States and never read the gospel or received an invitation to follow Jesus. Named after Tabitha, a disciple in the Early Church who was "always doing good and helping the poor" (Acts 9:36), this project creates natural launching points into gospel-centered conversations.

Open opportunities now for overlooked and underserved women to learn essential language skills, obtain work, overcome trauma, and find a new source of hope as they experience the love and care of Jesus.



Decades after Bosnia and Herzegovina's civil war, ethnic divisions still run deep. Evangelicals are one of the few groups willing to cross ethnic lines to bond with their neighbors. Even so, evangelicals are often viewed with distrust by the majority population.

You have an opportunity to renovate a camp that, for more than 20 years, has served as a welcoming environment for Alliance international workers to demonstrate Jesus' love in word and action toward people desperately searching for spiritual truth and hope.

The camp, located in a valley near the region's most famous natural lake, includes several buildings ravaged by war. Only one of these buildings has been renovated to accommodate campers—and this building can be used only during the summer. By giving to this project, you will improve and expand camp facilities so they can be used for conferences, workshops, retreats, and other gospel-advancing events throughout the year.

Shed Light on Human Trafficking

Each year, tens of thousands of women and girls are recruited from one North African country to pick strawberries in the fields of Spain. These strawberry field workers are often tricked into entering the sex industry with the promise of finding "better work" in Spain's crowded cities. With little money, education, and social influence, many endure these traumatic experiences in silence.

Through this project, you will launch a team of Alliance international workers on a tour of town halls, art exhibitions, universities, and other key sites in Spain to present original artwork, stories, and other resources that amplify the voices of those who have been unwittingly lured into and imprisoned by human trafficking. At the center of this awareness campaign will be a new book of stories and artwork, *The Strawberry Girls*.

Will you expose the struggle of hurting, vulnerable, and marginalized women and girls desperate to escape and heal from a dehumanizing lifestyle of manipulation and bondage?

Expand Refuge from Poverty and Violence

Many children in El Salvador grow up in neighborhoods filled with gang violence without the protection from their parents who are often forced to venture abroad to find work.


