We've been able to give them out to congregants, use copies in our services, and share copies with other churches. While many Roma can't read or write, it's very exciting to see those who can hold a Bible for the first time and read aloud from it!

Please continue to pray for those who attend as most of them have not yet put their faith in Christ. And pray for us as we seek to love and proclaim truth to this marginalized population.
